

**ORDINANCE NO. 17 – 80 Amended  
INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL**

**ESTABLISHING SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FEES FOR THE CITY OF ZANESVILLE,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 09-116 last established residential charges to defray the cost of solid waste disposal in the City of Zanesville; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost associated with new capital equipment, and costs burdens on the overall operating sanitation budget requires an increase in the residential sanitation charge; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sanitation Division is in urgent need of additional funds for the purchase of two (2) new solid waste trucks, as without such, the Division could experience a disruption to the day-to-day operations; therefore, it is in the public interest that this ordinance should become effective prior to the thirty days after passage.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Zanesville, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION ONE:** Effective August 1, 2017, there is hereby established a residential solid waste disposal fee of \$21.00 per month on every benefited household in the City of Zanesville collection area. If the account is carried in the name of an individual who is 65 years of age or older, then the residential solid waste disposal fee for the household shall be \$9.50 per month after completion of the required documentation annually and approval by the Utility Billing department. Households who currently have an individual who is between the ages of 60 and 64 years of age and already are receiving the discounted rate of \$3.35 will be grandfathered to the new discounted rate of \$9.50.

**SECTION TWO:** Effective August 1, 2017, there is hereby established a residential solid waste disposal fee of \$1.00 per month on every benefited household in the City of Zanesville collection area to be deposited in a solid waste equipment capital replacement fund to be utilized solely for replacement and major maintenance of solid waste collection and handling equipment.

**SECTION THREE:** Effective August 1, 2017, residential sanitation customers outside of the city municipal corporation limits who are also city water customers shall pay the rates listed in Sections One and Two about at 1.5 times that rate.

**SECTION FOUR:** Effective August 1, 2017, Ordinance No. 09-116, as amended, is hereby repealed.

**SECTION FIVE:** For the reasons stated above, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of six (6) or more members of City Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
