

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Zanesville intends to apply to the Ohio Department Services Agency for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program, a federally funded program administered by the state. The City of Zanesville is eligible for fiscal year 2019 CDBG Community Development funding, provided the city meets applicable program requirements. The City intends to make an application for up to \$500,000 in Critical Infrastructure funds.

On February 20, 2019 the City conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other important program requirements.

On September 9, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall, 401 Market Street, Zanesville, OH 43701, in the City Council Chambers, citizens will be given an opportunity to review and comment on the City's proposed CDBG Application the proposed activities summarized below, before the City submits its application to the Ohio Development Services Agency.

Citizens are encouraged to attend this meeting on September 9, 2019 to express their views and comments on the City's proposed CDBG application.

Based on both the Community Development Implementation Strategies, applications and local officials' assessment of the City's needs, the City is proposing to undertake the following CDBG activities for Fiscal Year 2019:

\$500,000 - Critical Infrastructure Project - Muskingum Avenue (Pine St. east to Railroad track):

1. Construction of a new roadway sub-base and asphalt surface course (with markings); storm water facilities, such as catch basins and curbing, and installation of pedestrian facilities and street lighting.

City Hall is a handicapped accessible facility.
