1. Communication from Rhonda Heskett, Budget and Finance Director – Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.281 the County Auditor's Office has certified that \$679,052.46 in Local Government Revenue will be allocated to the City of Zanesville for the Fiscal Year 2018.
2. Communication from Mayor Jeff Tilton-Zanesville Community Improvement Corporation Board-Mayor Tilton is hereby recommending the appointment of Susan Jones to the Zanesville Community Improvement Corporation Board. Ms. Jones will replace Randy Cassley completing the unexpired term ending on December 31, 2018.
3. Resolution No. 17-82 – Introduced by Council – A Resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission, authorizing the necessary tax levies, certifying them to the County Auditor, and declaring an emergency. (Emergency or First Reading)
4. Resolution No. 17-83 – Introduced by Council – A Resolution declaring "Beggar's Night"/"Trick or Treat" for the City of Zanesville. (First Reading)
5. Resolution No. 17 - 77 – Introduced by Council-A Resolution of the City of Zanesville, Ohio, requesting the Muskingum County Auditor to certify the total millage necessary to generate \$1.4 million dollars annually of property tax revenue for improvements to the City of Zanesville Transportation Network. (Second Reading)

Ordinance No. 17- 81– Introduced by Council – An Ordinance enacted by the City of Zanesville of Muskingum County, Ohio to replace the steel grate decking on the Sixth Street Bridge within the City of Zanesville as part of PID 104239, MUS-US 22-11.59 and declaring an emergency. (Emergency or First Reading)
7. Ordinance No. 17-84 - Introduced by Council - An Ordinance authorizing the proper city official to make a payment in an amount greater than the amount authorized by Ordinance #16-76 and declaring an emergency. (Emergency or First Reading)
8. Ordinance No. 17-85 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the proper city official to purchase Two (2) new trucks and two (2) new hoppers for the Sanitation Division through either a cooperative purchase program or through a competitive bidding process, and declaring an emergency. (Emergency or First Reading)
9. Ordinance No. 17-86 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the proper city official to enter into a contract for the purchase of a vehicle for the City Maintenance Division by State Purchase Agreement. (First Reading)
10. Ordinance No. 17-87 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the proper city official to enter into a professional contract with AECOM for updating the Combined Sewer Overflow Long-term Control Plan, Phase 1. (First Reading)
11. Ordinance No. 17-88 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the proper city official to accept funding and execute related intergovernmental agreements with the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District and the Ohio Department of Natural Resources; advertise for bids, award a construction contract, and expend funds for the Lock 10 Dam Debris Removal Project, and declaring an emergency. (Emergency or First Reading)
12. Ordinance No. 17-89 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the waiver of utility fees associated with the construction of two new Habitat for Humanity of Southeast Ohio’s Housing Development projects on Mead Street in the City of Zanesville. (First Reading)
13. Ordinance No. 17-90 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the City Auditor to accept a bid for a surplus vehicle greater than \$1,000 that was not listed on the prior surplus equipment sale ordinance. (First Reading)
