Mr. Roberts moved to adjourn. It was seconded by Mr. Sharrer.

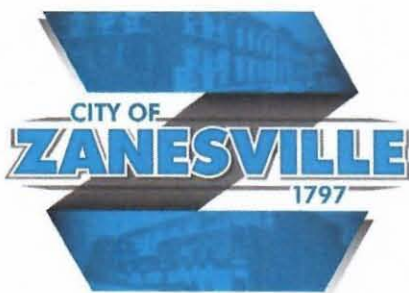
A voice vote was taken with all present being in favor. None were opposed. Mrs. Osborn was absent.

**RESOLUTION NO. 18 - 40
INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL**

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) PRECLUDE LASH PAVING INC. FROM BEING AWARDED ANY FURTHER PAVING BIDS WITHIN THE CITY OF ZANESVILLE, OHIO

WHEREAS; During 2016/2017 ODOT awarded the bid for paving within the City of Zanesville for portions of US 40, SR 146 and SR 60 to Lash Paving Inc.,

WHEREAS; Throughout the projects many issues came about as to the quality and timeliness of the work surrounding the paving and other activities, including but not limited to: segregation of asphalt material in the intermediate course and surface course, problems with the tack coat application and performance, inadequate traffic control coordination and methods, elevation differences between pavement and joints, issues with the application of joint sealing material, adjustment of water valve and manhole heights, catch basin grates sealed and shut from paving operations.

WHEREAS; the City of Zanesville has been disserved and harmed by these actions,

WHEREAS; the City of Zanesville believes that it is in the best interest of the public that this contractor be precluded from being awarded contracts bids or other work based on the aforementioned issues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Zanesville, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION ONE: That the Council of the City of Zanesville hereby requests that the Ohio Department of Transportation preclude Lash Paving Inc. from any further contract, bid or other work within the corporate bounds of the City of Zanesville.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

RESOLUTION 18- 41

**A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING ZANESVILLE CITY SCHOOLS
FROM CIVIL SERVICE LAWS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 124.011 the civil service commission of a municipality encompassing the largest portion of a local school district shall be the commission for that school district; and

WHEREAS, the City of Zanesville presently serves as the civil service commission for the Zanesville City School District; and

WHEREAS, the Zanesville City School District has expressed a desire to manage its own civil service matters as they relate to the Zanesville City School District; and

WHEREAS, the Zanesville City School District, under its home-rule authority, may enact an ordinance limiting the jurisdiction of its civil service commission to only city employees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it appropriate to support the request from the Zanesville City School District that the City of Zanesville Civil Service Commission take appropriate steps to limit its jurisdiction to matters pertaining to the City of Zanesville to the exclusion of matters related to the Zanesville City School District; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Zanesville, Ohio, that:

SECTION ONE: That the City Council, hereby supports the request of the Zanesville City School District to the Civil Service Commission of the City of Zanesville to take appropriate steps to empower the Zanesville City School District to handle matters related to civil and classified service positions with the Zanesville City School District.

SECTION TWO: That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to Donald Weitmarschen, Chairman of the Civil Service Commission for the City of Zanesville and to Doug Baker, Superintendent, Zanesville City School Board of Education, 956 Moxahala Avenue, Zanesville, Ohio 43701.

SECTION THREE: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION FOUR: This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
