ORDINANCE 18-89  
INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL

WAIVING THE RESIDENCE REQUIREMENT OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, Section 737.01 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes City Council to waive the residence requirements for the position of Director of Public Safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor desires to appoint Keane Toney as Safety Director; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Toney is not a resident of the City, but has agreed to secure housing within the city so as not to impair his ability to perform the duties of the Director of Public Safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the position of Director of Public Safety has been vacant for approximately three months, and the vacancy is creating a hardship within the departments under the direction of the director. It is therefore in the best interest of the residents and visitors of Zanesville, to have this ordinance passed as an emergency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council for the City of Zanesville, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION ONE:** City Council hereby approves the waiver of the residency requirement for Keane Toney while he holds the position of Director of Public Safety.

**SECTION TWO:** for the reason stated above, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure. Provided it receives the affirmative votes of six (6) or more members of Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
