Ordinance No. 18-130 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Zanesville, Ohio, by adding a new Chapter 926 Stormwater Utility Program, in order to establish a stormwater rate structure, which will provide for the funding of the operation, maintenance, and improvement of the stormwater system within the city limits.(First Reading)
2. Ordinance No. 18-131 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance repealing in its entirety Chapter 925.02 of the City's title Nine-Streets, Utilities and Public Services Code and enacting a new Chapter 925.02, Titled "Stormwater Utility Program Rate Structure and Fees. (First Reading)
3. Ordinance No. 18-132 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the disposal of personal property that is obsolete, unneeded, and unfit for public use pursuant to R.C. 721.15.(First Reading)
4. Ordinance No. 18-133 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Community Development to enter into an Economic Development Grant Agreement with the Zanesville/Muskingum County Port Authority for all activities related to the stabilization of at-risk properties located on Main Street. (First Reading)
5. Ordinance No. 18-134 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the proper City Official to advertise for bids for the Brighton Boulevard Resurfacing, and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder.(First Reading)
6. Ordinance No. 18-135 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance amending Ordinance 17-130, and declaring an emergency. (Emergency or First Reading)

7. Ordinance No. 18-136 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the proper City Official to apply for grant funding from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for the 2019 Community Development Recycling Grant and declaring an emergency. (Emergency or First Reading)
8. Ordinance No. 18-137 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the proper authority to pay an invoice to the Walter Drane Company for the preparation of 2018 Annual Codified Ordinance Supplement Services, and declaring an emergency. (Emergency or First Reading)
9. Ordinance No. 18-138 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance to revise the Codified Ordinances by adopting current replacement pages, and declaring an emergency. (Emergency or First Reading)

12. Ordinance No. 18-123 – Introduced by Council - An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Muskingum County Commissioners, for the reimbursement of fees paid to attorneys who represent indigent defendants in Municipal Court. (Third Reading)
