Ordinance No. 18-130 Amended – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Zanesville, Ohio, by adding a new Chapter 926 Stormwater Utility Program, in order to establish a stormwater rate structure, which will provide for the funding of the operation, maintenance, and improvement of the stormwater system within the city limits. (Second Reading)
8. Ordinance No. 18-131 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance repealing in its entirety Chapter 925.02 of the City’s title Nine-Streets, Utilities and Public Services Code and enacting a new Chapter 925.02, Titled “Stormwater Utility Program Rate Structure and Fees. (Second Reading)
9. Ordinance No. 18-133 – Introduced by Council – An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Community Development to enter into an Economic Development Grant Agreement with the Zanesville/Muskingum County Port Authority for all activities related to the stabilization of at-risk properties located on Main Street.
