ORDINANCE NO. 19-90
INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL

APPROVING A LABOR AGREEMENT WITH LOCAL #88, INTERNATIONAL
ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Local #88, International Association of Fire Fighters, hereinafter referred to as Local #88, has been recognized as the exclusive bargaining agent for permanent City employees occupying the position classification of Fire Fighter; and

WHEREAS, the City and Local #88 have reached a tentative agreement which has subsequently been approved by the members of the bargaining unit; and

WHEREAS, City Council must adopt the terms of the agreement in order for it to go into effect; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4117.10 (B), City Council must approve or reject the proposed agreement within 30 days of its introduction or the agreement will be deemed approved, making it necessary for this ordinance to be declared an emergency measure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Zanesville, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION ONE: The labor agreement between the City of Zanesville and Local #88, International Association of Fire Fighters, and on file in the office of the Clerk of Council, is hereby approved.

SECTION TWO: The agreement authorized by this ordinance is intended to take effect January 1, 2019. If necessary due to delays in implementation, the pay rate increases within the agreement shall be retroactive to the first day of the first full pay period of 2019. If necessary due to delays in implementation, the Mayor is authorized to determine the date other provisions of the agreement shall take effect.

SECTION THREE: For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure. Provided it receives the affirmative votes of six (6) or more members of Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 19- 91
INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF ZANESVILLE, OHIO, BY ADDING A
NEW CHAPTER 1152 REGARDING TREE PRESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Zanesville recognizes trees enhance the urban environment, make the city more attractive and increase the quality of life for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Zanesville's commitment to urban forestry is exemplified in the establishment of the Shade Tree Commission in 1992; and

WHEREAS, the City of Zanesville's efforts and commitment to an urban forestry program have been recognized for the past 22 years through a Tree City USA designation; and

WHEREAS, through a comprehensive review of the Planning and Zoning Code, the Community Development Department has identified areas that require amending and/or updating; and

WHEREAS, according to Section 1117.01, "To adapt to changing development conditions and provide for the phased implementation of the City Comprehensive Plan, the Planning Commission may from time to time recommend, and Council may adopt, amendments to the provisions of the text of this Zoning Code ... as provided by the Ohio Revised Code"; and

WHEREAS, proper notification of the intent of this proposed legislation was given in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, after taking testimony and discussion, the Zanesville Planning Commission has recommended to City Council that Chapter 1152 be created and approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Zanesville, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 1152 is added to the Municipal Code of Zanesville, Ohio to be codified as Chapter 1152 titled "Tree Preservation" as shown in the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION TWO: It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of this Council.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
