

# The City of Zanesville's 2018 Neighborhood Grant Program

The City of Zanesville established the Neighborhood Grant Program to maintain and improve neighborhoods by supporting activities that bring neighbors together and encourage participation. Through this competitive grant program, community members are provided with financial support for projects that enhance and strengthen their neighborhoods.

**Eligible applicants can apply for up to a \$1,000 grant for community projects. (If applying for more than \$500, the applicant must provide Neighborhood Match.)**

## Who's eligible?

Neighborhood-based organizations and groups of neighbors who do not belong to an organization are eligible.

## What kind of projects are eligible?

- **Community Building Events** such as neighborhood picnics and holiday events
- **Physical Improvements** such as minor landscaping and beautification projects
- **Communications and Operations** such as neighborhood mailings and website
- **Neighborhood Identity Projects** such as signage, public art, and banners
- **Leadership Training and Education** such as sponsoring resident training in CPR or First Aid.

Interested applicants should submit an application by July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018.
